Sacred Single Stone Mala Necklace

This is a one-stone focal mala using a bead tip and straight stringing on nylon.

bead = bede = prayer

a string of beads to wear and connect with divine spirit & the universe.

an outward touchable expression of all that is LOVE & sacred within.

adorn with aloha for affirmations and as a reminder of spirit.

you are beautiful.

Techniques:

straight stringing, knotting

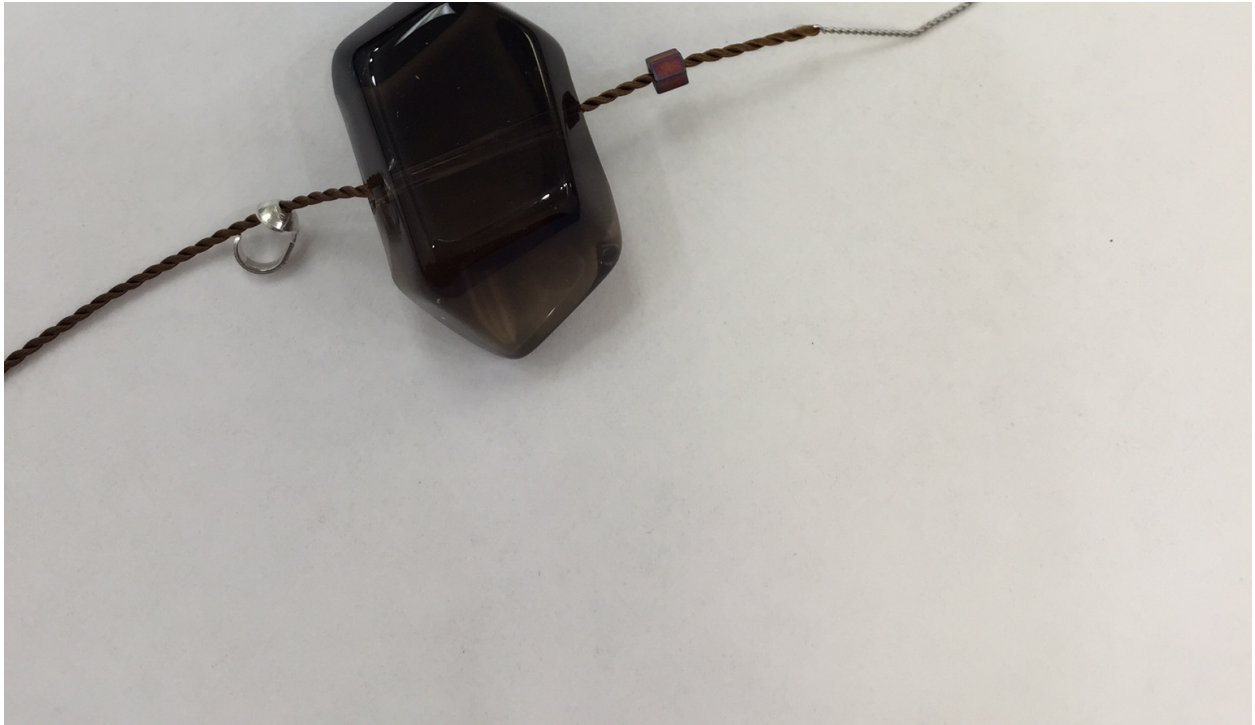
Tools you need:

chain nose plier
scissors
glue or lighter
knotting tweezer (optional)

Supplies:

108 wood beads (extra included, so please count)
seed beads
nylon cord #8 - 1 pack
bead tip - 2
tassel - 1





1. String on the bead tip with the hook facing outward, the focal and a seed bead.





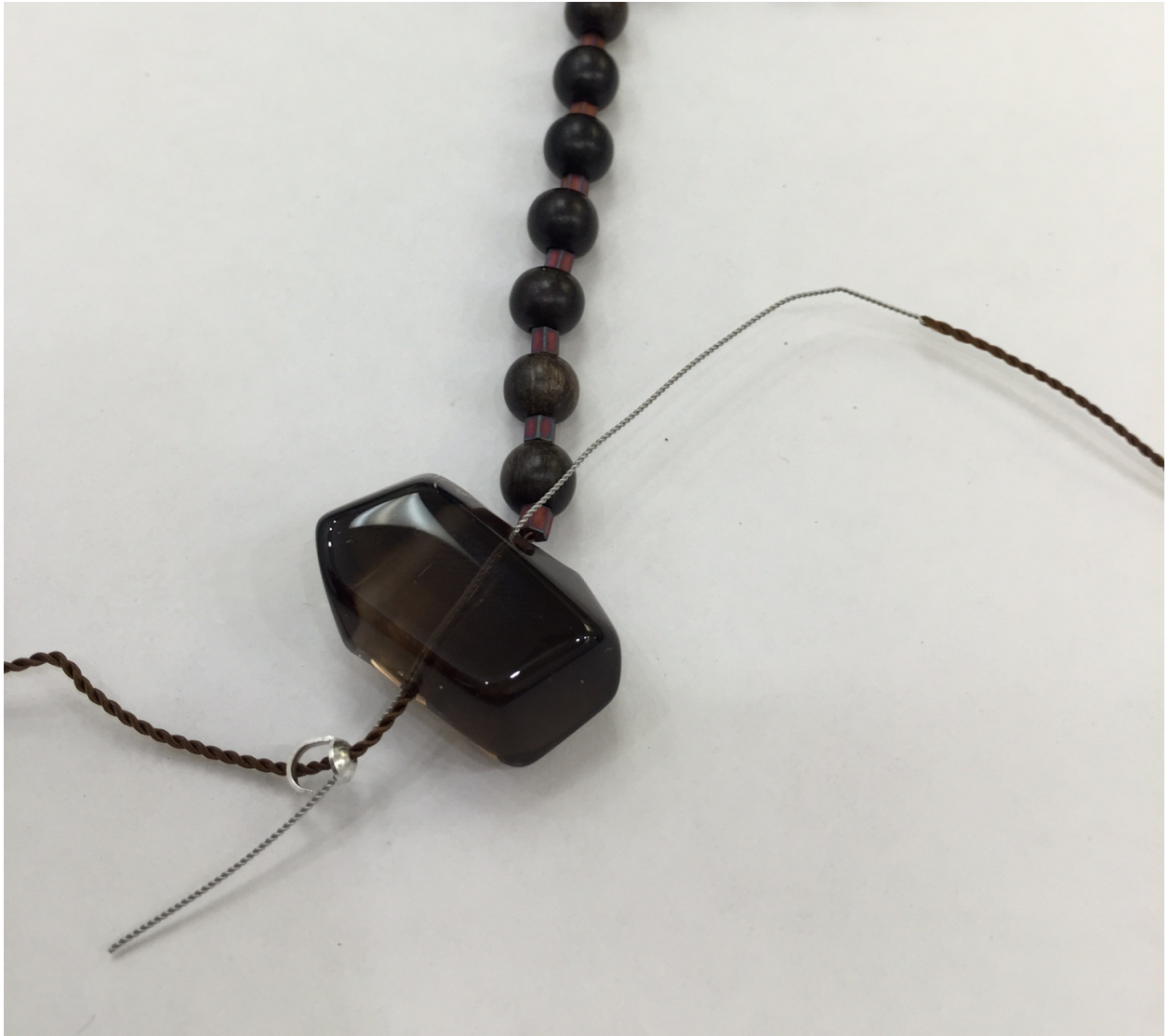
2. Continue alternating until you have 108 wood beads on your mala. Stay focused on your intentions, as it will energize your piece!





3. After the last seed bead, go back into the focal bead.





4. Then go into the bead tip.





5. Pull the slack out of the necklace, making sure there are no gaps between the beads. Don't pull so TIGHT that the necklace can't curve :)



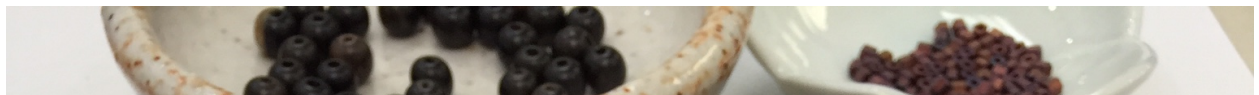


6. Tie a knot.





7. Tighten so it sits in the bead tip.





8. Tie one more knot.

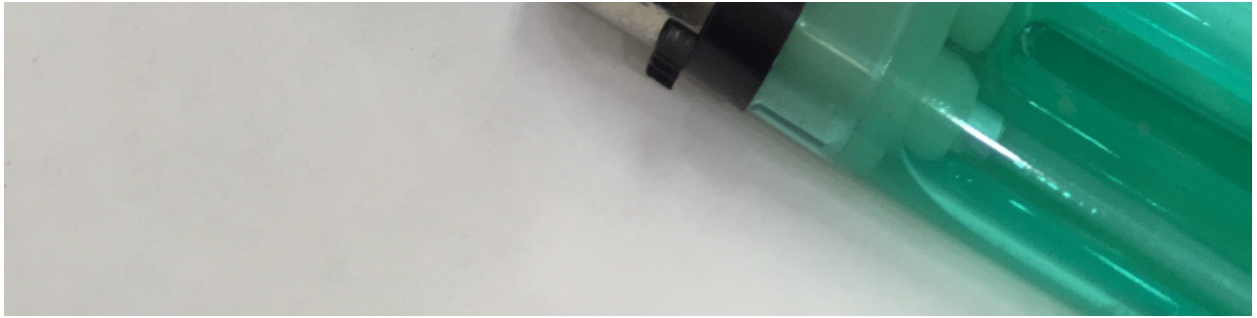


9. Cut the threads.



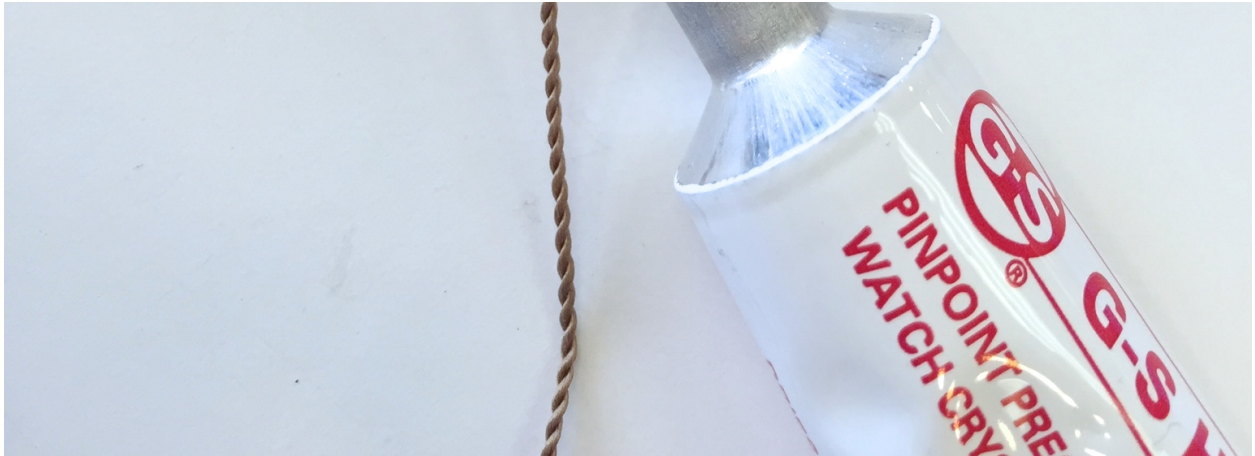
10. Leave about 1/8" if you are going to burn it down.





11. Burn ends until it melts to the knot.





12. Don't want to burn? Use glue :)





13. Put on the tassel.





14. Using a chain nose pliers, press the end of the bead tip into the cup.





15. WEAR your mala!!
